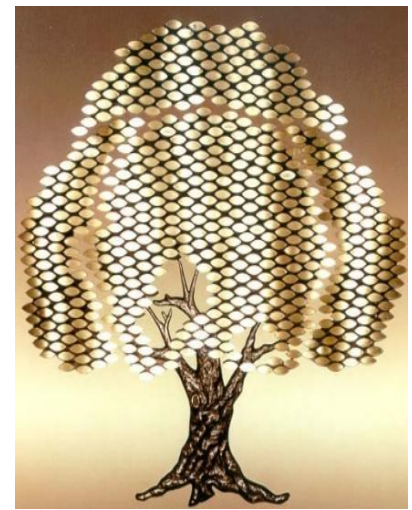

Oakmont Presbyterian Church Donor and Memorial Tree

The Donor and Memorial Tree grows on the wall in the Fifth Street entrance. It symbolizes the strength and growth of our church in many ways:

- The **ROOTS** represent our church planted firmly in Christian faith.
- The **BRANCHES** extend like many ways by which our church reaches out to all of us, our community and the world.
- The **LEAVES** grow to commemorate the lives and contributions of our members. The tree is a special way to show your faith, love and support of the Oakmont Presbyterian Church.

Types of Contributions

The leaves recognize all non-operating gifts received. Gifts not recognized on the tree include contributions to the general fund, operating funds, and mission.

Categories of Leaves

There are several types of donations the leaves are intended to recognize:

- ◆ gift to a specific campaign.
- ◆ gift given in memory of an individual(s).
- ◆ gift given to honor an individual(s).
- ◆ gift to the Memorial Program.

All memorials given in one person's name will be cumulative and acknowledged by a single leaf when the minimum donation of \$1,000 is reached. The wording on the leaf will be discussed with the family. Final wording on leaves is at the discretion of the Endowment and Memorial Gift Committee.

Individual plaques, such as those formerly used throughout the building will no longer be authorized.
